RE: Senate Page Program and COVID-19

The Senate Clerk's Office tentatively plans to reinstate Senate Page service and the Senate Page Program beginning in January 2022.

The following information only pertains to applicants seeking a Senate Page position and admission to the Senate Page Program.

- All students who accept an offer of admission into the program are required to receive a full COVID-19 vaccination at least two weeks prior to orientation (tentatively scheduled for Sunday, January 9, 2022).
- Students who receive admission to the program must submit a copy of their COVID-19 vaccination card with all other health and employment paperwork.
- Temperature checks will be required each weekday morning upon arrival at the Senate Page Room door.

Senate Page duties and program components are subject to change and cancellation. The Senate Clerk's Office will continue to monitor the impacts of COVID-19 on day-to-day operations.
